

ZORAN BOŽIČ is an assistant professor at the Faculty of Humanities at the University of Nova Gorica. During his doctoral studies at the Faculty of Arts in Ljubljana in 2010 he prepared his dissertation entitled *Poezija Franceta Prešerna v srednješolskih učbenikih in njena recepcija* (dealing with problems of canonizing, didactics and reader's response), which has also been published as a book (entitled *Slovenska literatura v šoli in Prešeren*).

For more than thirty years, he has been teaching Slovenian language and literature at the High School of Economics and has also written two manuals for home reading entitled *Zlati poljub* and *Poljub zlata*. The manuals introduce sixty narrative and dramatic texts from the Slovenian and world literature, presented as a learning chain based on fragments and supplemented with questions for close reading.

In the last few years he has published several scientific papers in countries such as USA *Prosification - a didactic means of improving reception of Krst pri Savici (The Baptism at the Savica)* (2010), Estonia *France Prešeren's poems: from misunderstanding to teaching* (2013), Slovakia *Evaluation of France Prešeren's poems* (2014) and Canada *The problem of interpreting and receiving Prešeren's poem To the Poet* (2014). Also in 2014, his scientific monograph with the title *France Prešeren's poems: understanding, evaluation, interpretation: reception-based approach to the poetry of the most important Slovenian romantic poet* was published in Germany.
