

Associate Professor and clinical pharmacology specialist Mihajlo B. Jakovljevic, MD, PhD, born 1978 in Belgrade, Serbia, is the leader of largest budget financed, research project on health economics (OI 175014) in Serbia, the only one of its kind; the duration of approved funding from Ministry of Science, 2011-2014. During school year 2012/2013 he was serving on behalf of Hosei University Tokyo, Japan as the Visiting Associate Professor of health economics teaching PhD students of the Graduate School of Economics where Japanese National Center for Population Aging is seated. Since 2009 in his home institution (historical birthplace of Serbian higher education) University of Kragujevac, he is running obligatory graduate Pharmacoeconomics Curriculum. In past ten years (2003-2013), he has conducted joint research projects and/or academic exchanges at counterpart foreign institutions of Hosei University Tokyo Japan; Department of Public Health University of Birmingham, UK; The Ghent University, Belgium; Universities at Nijmegen and Amsterdam, The Netherlands; The Institute of Pharmacology at The Vienna Medical University, Austria and The Pharmaceutical Faculty University of Ljubljana, Slovenia, with some of them still in process. These programmes were financed by the host institution's scholarships originating from governmental funds - EACPT, Royal Norwegian Grant, CEEPUS, WUS-OAD, BASILEUS – EU Commission's Grant and Hosei University Internal Research Fund. He has published more than 45 full text papers including 15 being indexed at Medline, has current citing rate of 73; most of them dealing with health economic issues (CEA, CUA, Cost of Illness, Solicited reviews etc). He has had many presentations at international congresses such as invited lectures/oral sessions held at: World Pharma Meeting, Copenhagen Denmark July 2010, 3rd ICDDT Dubai, UAE February 2011, ESBRA Vienna Austria September 2011, 6th JHEA in Tokyo, Japan September 2011, Psychiatric Association for Eastern Europe and the Balkans meeting Belgrade, Serbia 2012 and ESBRA 2013 held in Warsaw, Poland. He has conducted numerous peer-reviewing for different journals in the field such as Bulletin of World Health Organization, WHO; Value in Health, Elsevier, ISPOR; European Journal of Health Economics, Springer Verlag; Epilepsy research, Elsevier; Drug Metabolism Letters, Bentham Publishers etc. He serves as Senior Editorial board member on behalf of four international journals: „Chinese Journal of Clinicians (CJC)“ Publisher Chinese Medical Chamber, China, Editorial Board Member since 2011; „Journal of Health Behavior and Public Health (HBPH)“, Publisher Academy Science Society, New Jersey, USA Editorial Board Member since 2010; „Value in Health Regional Issues (VIHRI)“ Publisher Elsevier, Lawrenceville, NJ: ISPOR, USA Editorial Advisory Board Member since 2013; „Farmeconomia.
