

My name is Ade Maman Suherman, professor of international law, born in Kuningan-West Java 11 July 1967 Indonesia. I work for my Institution, Faculty of law Jenderal Soedirman University. I graduated from faculty of law Jenderal Soedirman University in 1990, and then I continued my master degree majoring in international business at University of Groningen The Netherlands from 1999-2001. During that period, I spent one semester at CERAM school of management in Nice France from January until June 1999.
