

Mark G. Spencer is Associate Professor of History at Brock University in St. Catharines, Ontario, Canada. His fourteen published volumes include his monograph on *David Hume and Eighteenth-Century America* (2005; paperback 2010), editorship of *David Hume: Historical Thinker: Historical Writer* (2013; paperback 2015), and *The Encyclopedia of the American Enlightenment* (2015). He has also edited several classic texts, including writings by Adam Smith (2012), Karl Marx (2013), John Locke (2014), and John Stuart Mill (forthcoming 2016). He sits on the *Editorial Boards of Enlightenment & Dissent* and *Hume Studies*, is a Consulting Editor for *The European Journal/Rivista Europea*, is a Board member of the Eighteenth-Century Scottish Studies Society (also its past-President), and a founding Trustee of the Robert T. and Moira Sansom Ideas Foundation. Professor Spencer is a Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries of Scotland and of the Royal Historical Society.
