Dr. Marko Filijović was born on October 11, 1982 in Pančevo, Republic of Serbia. He obtained his PhD at the Faculty of Security Studies, University of Belgrade on November 14, 2014 with the thesis “Islamic Fundamentalism and protection of the state (Comparative Case Study – North Caucasus and West Balkans)”.

He is a member of the Eurasian Security Forum in Belgrade which monitors and analyses the current state of World Security with its focus on Europe and Asia. He is currently employed by the Forum as a researcher. He is also an active member of the editorial board of the International Law Journal published by Canadian Center of Science and Education, Toronto, Canada as well as a member of the reviewers’ committee of the International Problems Journal published by the Institute of International Politics and Economics.

Furthermore, Dr. Filijović cooperates with many scientific, academic and other types of institutions in Serbia and abroad such as the Ukrainian Center for Independent Political Studies - UCIPR, Kiev, Ukraine; the Balkan magazine, an e-magazine edited in Belgrade, Serbia; Bureau for Social research, Belgrade, Serbia and others.

He has published more than 20 papers in scientific journals in the country and abroad as well as participated in numerous international conferences.

The area of his scientific interest is: international, regional and national security; regional studies (the Balkans, wider Black sea region, Euro-Asia); human security studies; geopolitics (especially the so-called Geopolitics of the Arctic, Geopolitics of Natural resources and Cosmic geopolitics); conflict prevention and conflict resolution; peace and conflict studies and counter-terrorism.
