

**Dr. John Moraros** is a public health scholar with an international education and field work experience. He is an Associate Professor of Epidemiology and Behavioral Science/Health Disparities, School of Public Health, University of Saskatchewan, where he maintains an active interdisciplinary teaching and research agenda.
