

Curriculum Vitae: Trevor Budhram

Dr Trevor Budhram is a senior lecturer at the Department of Police Practice, University of South Africa (Unisa). He holds a Phd in Police Science and a master's degree in Forensic Investigation from Unisa. His main interest is in addressing white collar crime, corruption and intelligence led-policing. He was a member of the South African Police Service for 11 years of which the majority of his career was spent investigating white collar crime. He also held portfolios in various public and private sector organisations in which he was responsible for combating white collar crime, corruption, maladministration and irregularities.

He has contributed to developing short learning programmes in the field of forensic investigation and has reviewed and developed undergraduate qualifications in Forensic Science and Technology. Dr Budhram has presented at local and international conferences and has published on white collar crime, corruption and intelligence-led policing. He serves as the chairperson of the Policing Association of Southern Africa (*POLSA*) and sits on various committees at Unisa.
