

**Prof. Dr Bart Vandenabeele** is a member of the Department of Philosophy at Ghent University (Belgium), where he teaches Aesthetics, History of Contemporary Philosophy, and Modern and Contemporary Art Theory. He has published chiefly in the areas of philosophical aesthetics, the philosophy of language and communication, and the history of modern philosophy (esp. Kant, Schopenhauer, and Nietzsche). His recent research focuses on the beautiful, the sublime, tragedy, aesthetic contemplation, and the values of (contemporary) art. His book publications include *Seduction, Community, Speech* (2004) and *The Blackwell Companion to Schopenhauer* (2012). He has been a visiting scholar and visiting professor at several universities, including the University of Oxford (U.K.), the University of Stellenbosch (South Africa), and Missouri Western University (USA). He is an associate editor of *Empedocles: European Journal for the Philosophy of Communication* and a Vice-Chair of the Philosophy of Communication Section of ECREA.
