The [Athens Institute for Education and Research](http://www.atiner.gr) organized its **11th Annual International Conference on Tourism**, on Monday 8 June 2015 and Tuesday 9 June 2015, Titania Hotel (52 Panepistimiou Street), Athens, Greece.

The welcome and opening remarks of the conference took place on **Monday 8 June 2015**, at **9:30 a.m.** and were given by Dr. **Gregory T. Papanikos**, President of the Institute & Honorary Professor, University of Stirling, UK & Dr. **Valia Kasimati**, Head, Tourism Research Unit, ATINER.

During the first two days of the conference, 29 papers were presented by 31 academics and researchers from 17 different countries (Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, Croatia, Egypt, Hong Kong, India, Lebanon, Philippines, Poland, South Africa, Spain, Taiwan, Turkey, UK and USA).
