## ATINER's Mission

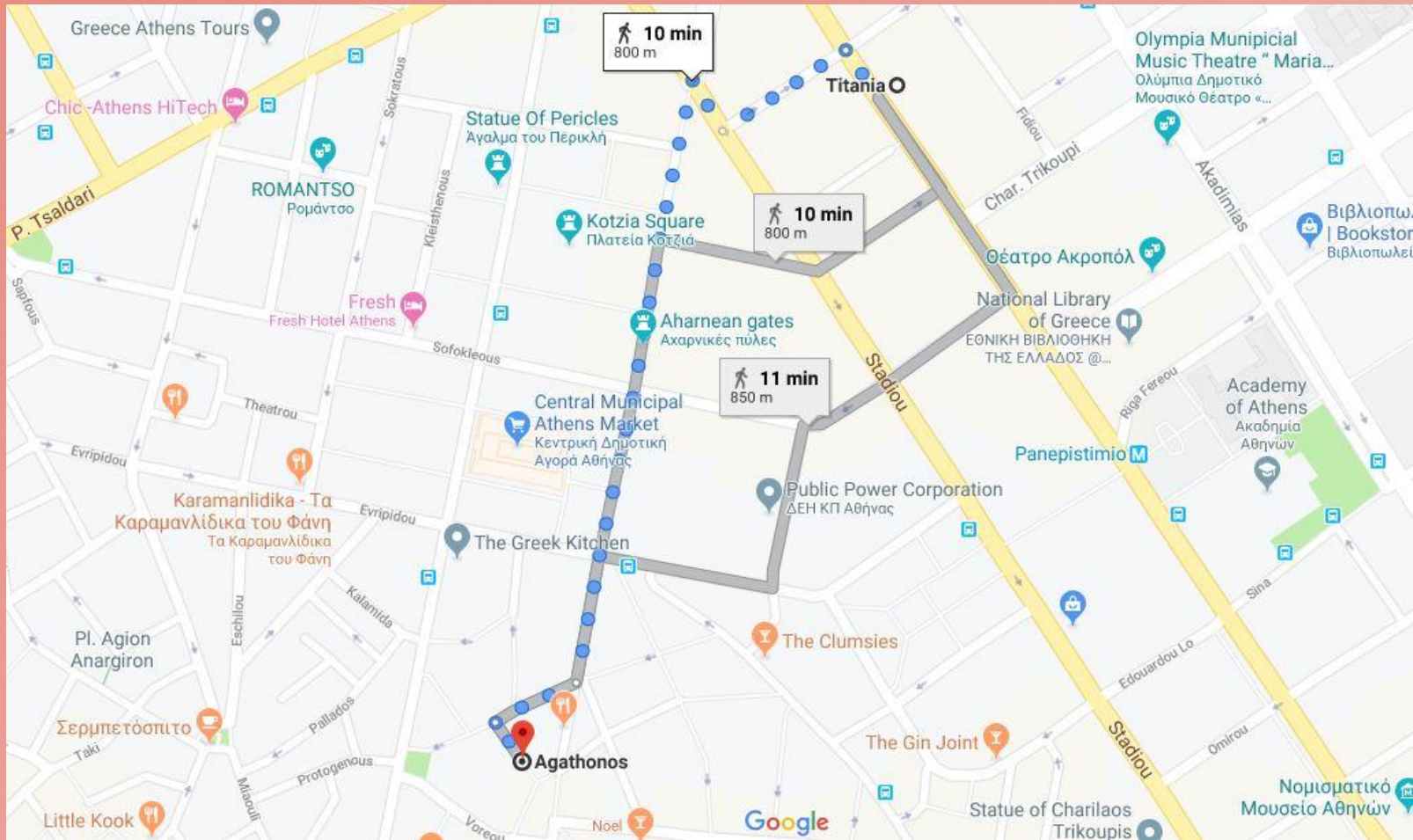

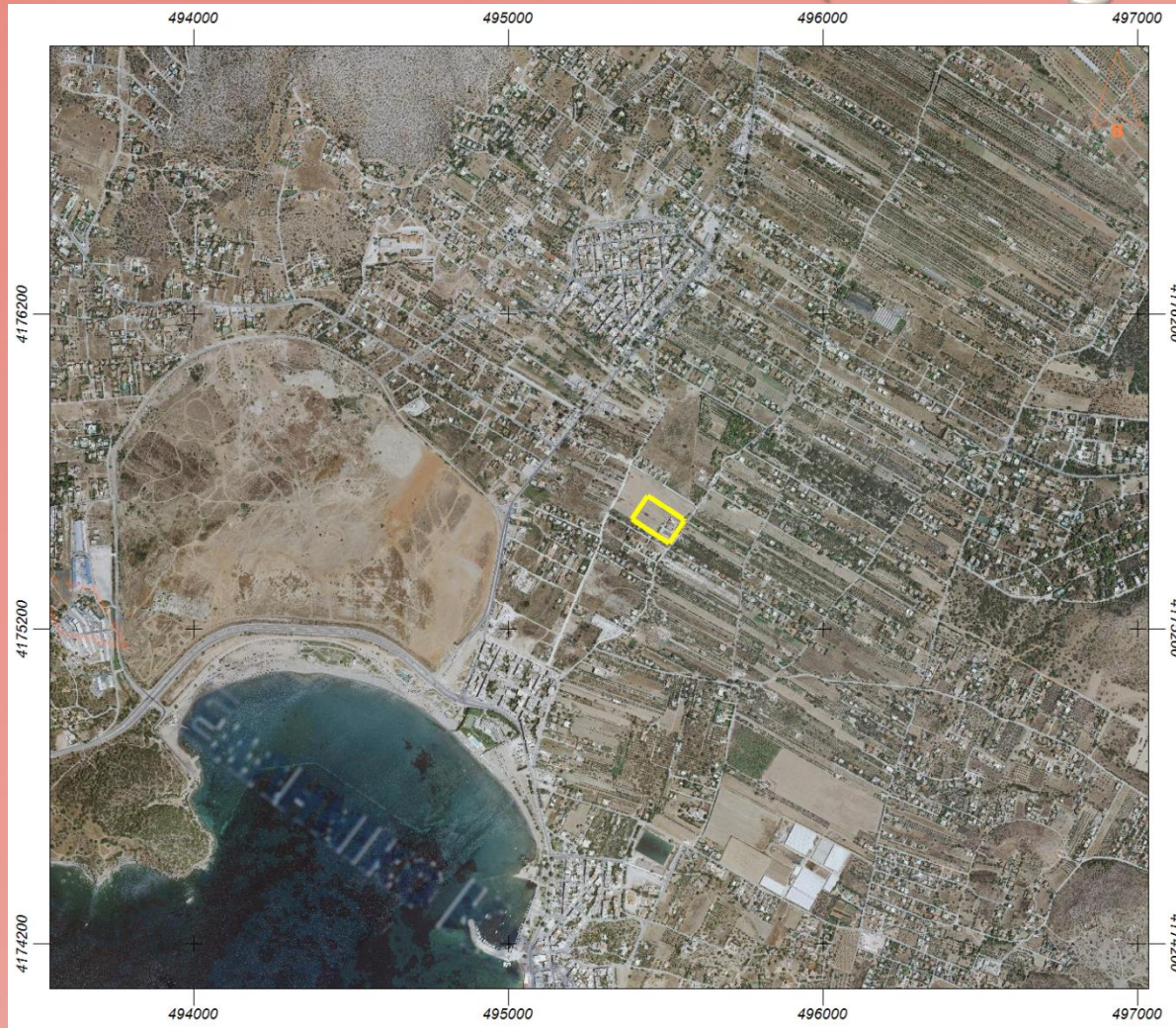

His intervention was the last and not in the program. He spoke under the heavy influence of alcohol and who knows what else. ATINER does this many times for latecomers but not for the uninvited.</b></p>

## Some Facts about ATINER

- ❖ ATINER has over 2500 members from 117 countries organized in 37 Units, 6 Divisions and 6 Centers.
- ❖ 6000 academics from 150 countries have volunteered their services to help with reviewing.
- ❖ Every year close to 2000 researchers present their papers to one of ATINER's conferences and other events
- ❖ In total, more than 20,000 researchers have come to Athens and presented papers to one or more conferences organized by ATINER since 1995.



## Basic Activities

- ▶ International conferences and symposiums, academic dialogues, public speeches, and roundtable discussions.
- ▶ Assist in hosting courses in Athens accredited by other universities. Quite a few over the years but not on a regular base (University of Maryland, University of Georgia, Sam Houston University, University of Ottawa, and Nanyang University of Singapore).
- ▶ Autonomous Summer Courses.
- ▶ Research (PhD studentship, external funding based on members initiative)
- ▶ Hosting visiting researchers, fellows, etc (self-funded).

# Anglo-Hellenic PhD Studentships

This is a unique opportunity to gain a PhD through conducting empirical research on a topic of importance to Greek society, business, or policy. Funded in partnership with the Athens Institute of Education and Research (ATINER) and Stirling Management School, three successful candidates will receive a yearly stipend of 10,000 euro (provided by ATINER) plus yearly tuition fees (worth a further 4,500 euro per year). The candidates will be based in both Stirling, UK, and Athens, Greece. Students will be part of the Anglo-Hellenic PhD Community. This is a unique opportunity to work alongside leading British and Greek academics, gain experience of two cultures, conduct research of national importance, and develop a genuinely European approach to research.

# Publications

1. Abstract Books (4 days after the conference)
2. ATINER's Conference Presentation Series (based on submission)
3. Online Paper Series (based on submission and reviewing)
4. Books: Collection of Papers from various conferences [200 books have been published by ATINER by 865 authors/editors]
5. 15 e-Journals. In 2016 the acceptance rate was less than 20% BUT ... the denominator needs better papers.



# e-Journals

- ▶ A unique Blind Review Process:  
<https://www.athensjournals.gr/review>, inviting the world academic community to comment on the paper. This serves the purpose of transparency of the entire blind review process.
- ▶ No fee for submission, processing-editing publishing, open access paid by authors, open access paid by readers etc
- ▶ The intellectual property rights of the submitted papers remain with the author.



## Get involved

- ▶ Become a member (not a fixed cost but a small annual fee).
- ▶ Organize a conference-symposium-stream- panel-session conferences.
- ▶ Review and/or submit papers for publication.
- ▶ Organize a summer/visiting course
- ▶ Suggest something else, pending you have the resources (money and time) to implement it.



## Paper Presentations

- ▶ Chairpersons will use *3 minute* and *1 minute* reminder cards because we follow **Socrates** suggestion (see Plato's Protagoras): "... elect a judge (ῥαβδοῦχον) or a foreperson (ἐπιστάτην) or a chairperson (πρότανιν) so you keep the length of each one's speech short (ὅς ὑμῖν φυλάξει τὸ μέτριον μῆκος τῶν λόγων ἑκατέρου).
- ▶ For technical assistance – contact admin. representative before the session commences.

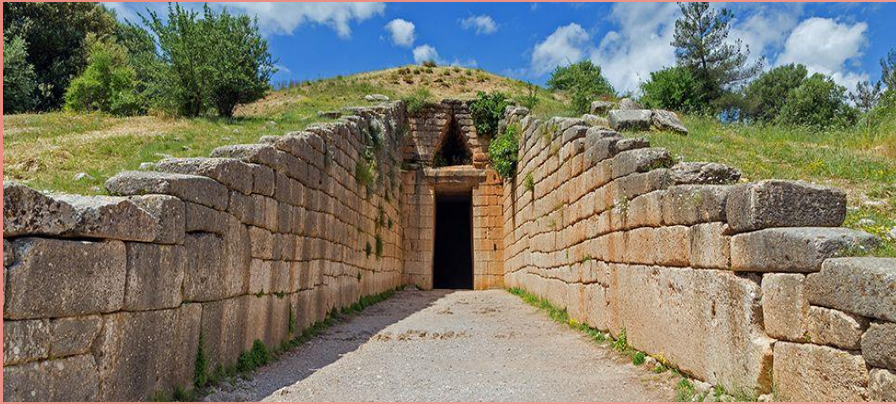
