

Ahmadreza ASHRAFOLOGHALAEI is a native speaker of Farsi (Persian) Language, 50, living in Tehran, Iran, and holding his DBA Certificate as well as his M.A. Degree in TEFL. Although working as a civil servant in Iran's MPO (Management and Planning Organization) affiliated to the Presidential Office, he has also been teaching English simultaneously since 1990 in various Iranian universities, and once in China in 2005. Although retired now from MPO, he is still active in teaching and translating.

Ahmadreza is also a professional translator (so far with over 14 books published by Iran's Productivity Organization (NIPO), State Management Training Center (SMTC), University of Disciplinary Sciences Press, Iran Daily Institution, and other publishers), and more than 100 domestic articles/papers printed in various domestic periodicals, and about 8 international papers presented in international gatherings, some already published. He has been the translator of Iran's First MDGs national report published by MPO and UNDP office in Tehran. Ahmadreza has also been the first who introduced audio-management learning through cassettes and cds in 1991 in the Islamic republic of Iran. He also started the publication of a management periodical named "*the Latest in Management*" in Farsi) in the then SOAE (State Organization for Administrative and Employment Affairs now MPO)

Dr. Ashrafologhalaei had been also working for IRNA (Islamic Republic News Agency) for 4 years as a journalist and Farsi-English translator (1984-1988). Meanwhile, he cooperated with an Iranian Daily named Etemad in 2000-2001 in the field of management and administrative sciences. He has also been cooperating with IRIB (Islamic Republic of Iran Broadcast).

Ahmadreza is now both teaching English (reading, writing, translation) at Islamic Azad university as well as University of Applied Science and Technology, while cooperating with some Chinese and Indian (as well as Iranian) translation agencies in the field of Farsi-English-Farsi translation projects.
