<u>Short bio note</u>: Dr Roberta Cruciata is Expert on the Subject History of Art and Decorative Arts in Italy and in the Mediterranean area in the Department Culture e Società at the University of Palermo. She is member of the scientific committee of the Osservatorio per le Arti Decorative in Italia "Maria Accascina".

Her research concerns the decorative arts with particular emphasis on the Sicilian decorative arts in Malta and on artistic and cultural relations between the two islands of the Mediterranean at the time of the Knights of the Order of St. John (1530-1798). Other privileged field of investigation is the history of Sicilian jewellery of the age between the end of the 18th and the beginning of the 20th century in relation to the wider Mediterranean and European context.

She has lectured extensively on these subjects in several national and international conferences. She is author of three monographs, numerous essays and articles for national and international books and scientific magazines.
