

Abdelfattah A. Dababat is a native of Palestine – West Bank. He is the leader of the Soil Borne Pathogens at CIMMYT-Turkey program based in Ankara. In 1996 he graduated from the Faculty of Agriculture – departments of plant production and protection at the Al-Najah National University in Nablus. In 1999 he obtained his master degree in Plant Production/Agronomy from the University of Jordan in Amman. During his master he worked as a teaching assistant to teach theoretical and practical courses for undergraduate students. In 2009 - 2013 he worked at the Palestinian Agriculture Research Center (NARC) for a trilateral project among Germany, Israel and Palestine working on the biological control of root knot nematodes. During that period he worked as part time lecturer in local universities. In 2003, he received a PhD scholarship offer from the German KAAD to complete his PhD studies at Bonn University, where, also did his post doctorate from 2007-2009. In 2009, he received a 2nd post doctorate offer from the International Maize and Wheat Improvement Center (CIMMYT) to work on the soil borne pathogens at CIMMYT- Turkey office. In 2011 he appointed as the leader of the program. He has co-supervised/co-supervising more than 17 Master and PhD students from around the world. He has published more than 40 peer-reviewed articles and more than 60 proceedings, abstracts, and manuals.
