Rung Eduard lectures at Kazan Federal University. He teaches the history of the Ancient world and classical languages (Ancient Greek and Latin). He is Professor in Ancient History and author more than 100 publications, including two monographs, articles and book chapters. His research interest are focused on the History of the Persian Empire, Greco-Persian diplomatic relations, interstate relations in ancient Greece, political and cultural relations between Greece and the East, Greek perception of the East and Eastern peoples. He led the scholarly project on patriotism and treason in antiquity in the past, and he is now going to be leader of the project on the interaction between religions and politics in the ancient world, attended a number of prestigious international conferences, symposiums and congresses, including 22th international congress of historical sciences in Jinan, China, in 2015.
