With a degree in Humanities (1989) and a PhD (2007) in Greek Literature, she is an Assistant Professor at the Universidade Católica Portuguesa (UCP -CRBraga), where she teaches since 1990 several curricular units, mainly in the area of Classical Studies. She is an integrated member of the *Centre for Philosophical and Humanistic Studies* (CEFH) of the same institution. Her research has focused on the themes of Greek and Latin Language and Literature, Classical Culture, Religion and Mythology, and their reception in Portuguese Literature. She has participated as a speaker and has organised several international scientific meetings on the survival of themes and authors from Antiquity, and has published various texts resulting from them. She is the Librarian Professor at *Faculty of Philosophy and Social Sciences*, the Librarian Professor at the *Theology Faculty*, both from the UCP and the Secretary of the *Revista Portuguesa de Humanidades* (Portuguese Journal of Humanities), from the FFCS.
