

At present, Professor Francesco Scalera is adjunct professor in Business Administration and General Accounting at "Aldo Moro" University of Bari. In the previous years he held a post as a lecturer in the following disciplines: Applied Accountancy, Business Strategy and Policy, International Management, Management Planning and Control, Business Organization and Human Resources Management. He is author of over 60 international publications dealing with such subjects as: SMEs development in transition countries, the business climate in the new emerging economies, waste marketing, the development of Fiat and Peugeot automotive companies, the role of Business Angels in the Balkan area and so on.

He also held a teaching post as visiting professor in prestigious foreign Universities in France, Argentina and Albania.
