He is a Senior Economic Advisor at Applied Research and Analysis Directorate, Health Canada. He was a professor of economics at Research Institute of Economics and Management, Southwestern University of Finance and Economics, in Chengdu, China. During his career as an economist and a researcher for more than a decade, he has published numerous articles in peer reviewed journals including *Health Economics*, *Public Health Reports*, *Health Policy*, *Social Science & Medicine*, *Medical Care Research and Review*, *Applied Economic Letters* and has made numerous presentations.
