

A Short Biographical Note

Ranko Kozić (born on 29th April 1959 in Trebinje, Bosnia and Herzegovina), graduated in classical philology at the Faculty of Philosophy (University of Belgrade) in 1982, and a year later received a special prize for being the best graduate student in his generation at the institution referred to above. He teaches Latin morphology, syntax and stylistics to the students of Italian studies, and holds courses on the poetics and aesthetics of the classical novel for the students of doctoral studies at the above-mentioned faculty. His scholarly interests include the origins, the poetics and aesthetics of the Greek novel, the Latin love elegy, the philosophical foundations of the genres of erotic literature in antiquity and the philosophical poetics of the Second Sophistic. He is a member of the editorial board of *Athens Journal of Humanities and Arts*, and a regular participant in the annual international conferences on literature organized by ATINER (Athens Institute for Education and Research), and thus regular contributor to Athens Academic Journals.
