

Juan Antonio Martín Ruiz was born in San Fernando (Cádiz, España), archaeologist specialised in the Phoenician colonization and PhD. in History by the University of Málaga. Consultor Member for the Panel of Experts in the Social Sciences Doctorate Programme of the International University of Valencia. Member of the following institutions: Academia Andaluza de la Historia, Asociación Española de Historia Militar, Research Group *El Legado de la Antigüedad* in the University of Almería, Centro de Estudios Fenicios y Púnicos in the Universidad Complutense of Madrid, Instituto de Estudios de Ronda y la Serranía, Institución Gran Duque de Alba in Diputación Provincial of Ávila, and, finally, member of the Sociedad de Estudios del Valle del Tiétar.

Author of over 170 publications including books and articles, he has led numerous campaigns of surveys and archaeological excavations. Winner of the Degree Extraordinary Award in the Section of History awarded by the University of Malaga in 1992 and also winner of the First Prize in the Section of History at the 2nd and 4th editions of the *Award for Historical and Ethnographical Research* Villa de Mijas, given by the Mijas Town Hall in 2005 and 2012.

He is a member of the Scientific Committee of the following magazines: *Aljaranda*, *Revista de Estudios Tarifeños*, *Takurunna*, *Anuario de Estudios sobre Ronda y la Serranía* and *Menga.
