Dr. Papadopoulos, born in Greece, 2009 was elected as Professor of Plastic Surgery at the Munich Technical University in Germany, and since September 2014 is associate Professor of Plastic Surgery at the Democritus University of Thrace in Alexandroupoli, Greece.

His main interests are: "Fetal and Adult Wound Healing", "The role of Fibroblasts/Myofibroblasts in anti-aging", "Adipose- and Blood-Derived Stromal Cells for Cell Therapy", and "Quality of Life after Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery". For his engagement in these fields he received among others the "Hans Anderl Award 2006" of the European Association of Plastic Surgeons, and the "Karl Max von Bauernfeind-Medaille" of the Munich Technical University (2008) as member of team who performed the first bilateral upper extremities Allo-Transplantation, in Munich, June 25-26, 2008.

Dr. Papadopoulos is an active member of over 20 different national and international societies. He presented more than 300 lectures, courses and papers in 5 different languages in meetings, hospitals and universities worldwide and published more than 100 scientific publications with an H-index 20, and impact factor over 90.

Dr. Papadopoulos served as Co-Editor of the books entitled "Cleft lip and palate: Diagnosis and Treatment" (Mponisel 2013, Athens, Greece), and "Skin Cancer and Melanoma: Surgical Treatment and Reconstruction" (Springer, Germany, in press), as well as of the Supplement "Transsexuellenchirurgie [Transsexual-Surgery]" at the peer review Journal "Handchirurgie, Mikrochirurgie, Plastische Chirurgie". Additionally he contributed in other books with chapters, in Greece and abroad. He also is/or served as Member of the Editorial Board of 3 peer reviewed journals, and as Referee of 33 medical journals.

Dr. Papadopoulos served as President of the International Fetal Medicine and Surgery Society, as well as of the Hellenic Society for Reconstructive Microsurgery. Currently is elected as President of the Greek Society of Lymphology and Council Member of the European Association of Plastic Surgeons.
