- PhD (1992), Department of Byzantine and Modern Greek Studies, King's College, London.
- Organizer of three one-day conferences.
- Participant in two research programs and 17 History Conferences.
- Author of 14 history books (three jointly) and many articles.
- Editor-in-Chief of *Historica Themata* (Historic Themes), a monthly Greek historical journal (2001-2010) and of *Historia Ikonografemene* (History Illustrated), the oldest journal of popularized history in Greece (April 2022 ff.)
- Editor of five collective volumes, including a *Dictionary on the Byzantine Peloponnese* (in Greek), the 12th volume of journal *Mésogeios* (Paris, 2001), under the title *Byzance* (with studies on the Byzantine Empire), and *To Μικρασιατικό ζήτημα με τα μάτια των ξένων* (*The Question of Asia Minor in the Eyes of Foreigners*), Athens 2023.
- Areas of research interest include geographical, military and sociopolitical history of Greece, Southeastern Europe and the Middle East.
