



Prof. Dr. A. Zafer ACAR, is a full professor. After more than 20 years of logistics experience in the state service, he retired in 2008 at his own request and started his academic carrier at the university. In his academic career, he accomplished two master's degree from Gebze Technical University (GTU) in "Business Administration" and from Beykent University in "Logistics and Production Strategies". He received his PhD degree from GTU in 2008 with his thesis titled "*The Role of Resource-Based Business Capabilities in Providing Competitive Advantage*".

He carries out his academic studies on strategic management, supply chain and logistics management in accordance with his professional experience and academic education. He has many indexed (WoS; Scopus) articles published in academically prestigious international journals, published book chapters and presented papers at national and international conferences. He also contributed to the literature in the field of logistics and supply chain with six books: "*Storage and Warehouse Management*" (4 eds), "*Supply Chain Management: A Logistics Approach*" (4 eds), "*Warehouse and Distribution Centers Management*", "*Information Systems & Contemporary Technologies in Supply Chains: Concepts, Application, and People*", "*Logistics Management*" and "*Strategic Logistics Management*".

In parallel with such academic studies, he carries out joint studies and trainings with industrial associations and companies, and he became a member of the "Distinguished Specialization Commission for the Development of Logistics Services" within the scope of the 10th and 11th 5-Year Development Plan studies prepared under the coordination of the Ministry of Development, and moderated and edited the logistics chapter of the 2053 Strategic Transportation Plan under the supervision of Ministry of Transportation. He has published several articles in various newspapers, magazines and web pages for a long time. He gave lectures at various European universities within the scope of Erasmus programs, as well as worked as a visiting professor with a long-term contract at Poznan University of Economics and Business (PUEB). He is currently serving as the Dean of the Faculty of Applied Sciences at Istanbul Bilgi University.
