The <u>Athens Institute for Education and Research</u> organizes its 3rd Annual International Conference on Humanities & Arts in a Global World, on Sunday 3 January 2016 and Monday 4 January 2016, Titania Hotel (52 Panepistimiou Street), Athens, Greece.

The opening speech and the welcome remarks of the conferences will take place on **Sunday 3 January 2016**, at **8:45 a.m.** by Dr **Gregory T. Papanikos**, President of the Institute and Honorary Professor, University of Stirling, UK, Dr **George Poulos**, Vice-President of Research, ATINER and Emeritus Professor, University of South Africa, South Africa and Dr. **David P. Wick**, Director, Arts and Humanities Research Division, ATINER & Professor of History, Gordon College, USA.

During the two days of the conferences 35 papers will be presented by 40 participants from 17 different countries (Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Bulgaria, Hong Kong, India, Italy, Korea, Nigeria, Poland, Russia, South Africa, Sri Lanka, Turkey, UAE, UK and USA).
