RE: 9th Annual International Conference on Mediterranean Studies, 21-24 March 2016, Athens, Greece

The <u>Athens Institute for Education and Research</u> organized its **9th Annual International Conference on Mediterranean Studies**, on Monday 21 March 2016 and Tuesday 22 March 2016, Titania Hotel (52 Panepistimiou Street), Athens, Greece.

The opening speech and the welcome remarks of the conference took place on Monday 21 March 2016, at 8:30 a.m., and were given by Dr Gregory T. Papanikos, President of the Institute and Honorary Professor, University of Stirling, UK and Dr George Poulos, Vice-President of Research, ATINER and Emeritus Professor, University of South Africa, South Africa.

During the two days of the conferences 40 papers were presented by authors from 25 different countries (Albania, Algeria, Austria, China, Croatia, Cyprus, France, Germany, Greece, Iraq, Israel, Italy, Japan, Korea, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Russia, South Africa, South Korea, Turkey, UAE, UK and USA). In the sessions, as organized, the researchers presented their work on various topics connected to the Mediterranean Studies such as: education, arts and music, law, economics, media, politics, literature, culture and society. Military Spending was also among the main topics of the conference's research agenda. Furthermore, a Round-Table Discussion on *"The Current Refugee Crisis in the Mediterranean Basin"* was organized.
