The Arts and Humanities Division of the Athens Institute for Education and Research hosted its 5th Annual International Conference on Humanities & Arts in a Global World, sponsored by the Athens Journal of Humanities & Arts and ATINER's five centers (https://www.atiner.gr/centers).
