In total, about 50 papers will be presented, authored by nearly 60 researchers, coming from 30 different countries (Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Denmark, Egypt, Germany, Israel, Italy, Japan, Kosovo, Mexico, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Sri Lanka, Switzerland, The Netherlands, Turkey, UK, USA and Vietnam).
