ATINER's 2018 Conference high season continues on Monday 9 July with a series of Conferences and Symposia on Finance; Accounting; Languages & Linguistics; Architecture; and Higher Education in a Global World. The events will take place on Monday 9 July 2018 and Tuesday 10 July 2018, at the Titania Hotel, 52 Panepistimiou Avenue, Athens, Greece.
